HEALTH REQUIREMENTS FOR 2020 VIRGINIA BEEF EXPO BREEDING CATTLE
PLEASE PROVIDE THIS INFORMATION SHEET TO YOUR VETERINARIAN

All animals entered in the sales must meet the following requirements:

- A. Be officially identified with an “**840**” **RFID button issued by a state or federal animal health program** and entered on a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI) issued by an accredited veterinarian within 30 days of the sale.

Out of State Cattle: Permit Number Required

1. Electronic Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (eCVI) from Global Vet Link or AgView

OR

2. Paper CVI with permit number. For more information on obtaining a permit number go to www.vdacs.virginia.gov/animals-cattle.shtml or contact:

- B. CVI shall list each animal’s LOT NUMBER, “840” RFID number, age, sex, breed, Brucellosis vaccination status, and test results and dates of tests. Cattle that have “Tests Pending” will be rejected.
- C. Cattle originating from the states of Alabama, Arizona, Arkansas, California, Colorado, Florida, Georgia, Idaho, Illinois, Iowa, Kansas, Kentucky, Louisiana, Mississippi, Missouri, Montana, Nebraska, Nevada, New Mexico, North Carolina, Oklahoma, Oregon, South Carolina, South Dakota, Tennessee, Texas, Utah, Washington and Wyoming shall also be negative for **Blue Tongue and Anaplasmosis** if there is a likelihood they may be sold to a buyer in Maine, New York, or Vermont. Cattle originating from Virginia, West Virginia, Pennsylvania and Maryland are exempt from the Blue Tongue and Anaplasmosis test requirements.
- D. All non-virgin breeding bulls under 18 months of age or bull’s greater than 18 months of age requires a Negative Trich test within 30 days of entry.
- E. All of the above test information shall be included on the CVI
- F. Animals must be free of infectious and contagious diseases, including **Ringworm, Warts, and Pinkeye**
- G. Meeting the entry requirements for Virginia does not guarantee entry into other states.... Animals not meeting the above requirements may be refused admission and may not be sold.
- II. The above CVI’s accompanying each animal shall be delivered to your respective breed’s sale manager upon immediate arrival to the fairgrounds **April 16,2020**. **Make enough copies of each CVI to represent each LOT, i.e. is 6 lots are on one CVI, make 6 copies.**

These requirements are a compilation of the 2020 Virginia Beef Expo Committee and Interstate Import Requirements.

Please do not wait until the last minute to examine this paper and heed its recommendations.
